Thank you for your continued patience, understanding, and prayers. Our staff has been working diligently to ensure the safety and well-being of our residents. While the number of COVID-19 cases in Blair County rose significantly in September, we are managing any potential exposures and mitigating risk within our community. The facility continues to work with The Department of Health at both the local and state level. Furthermore, we continue to partner with individuals affiliated with the Regional Congregate Care Assistance Teams to mitigate potential exposures and safeguard our residents. New COVID-19 regulations outline several approaches for COVID outbreaks, including contract tracing versus a broad-based approach, and we are working with officials to ensure we are utilizing the best practices available. While the Court Apartments remain in a unique position, as the building connects to our nursing home and cares for both independent and personal care residents, scheduled visitations remain available for the facility as a whole.
